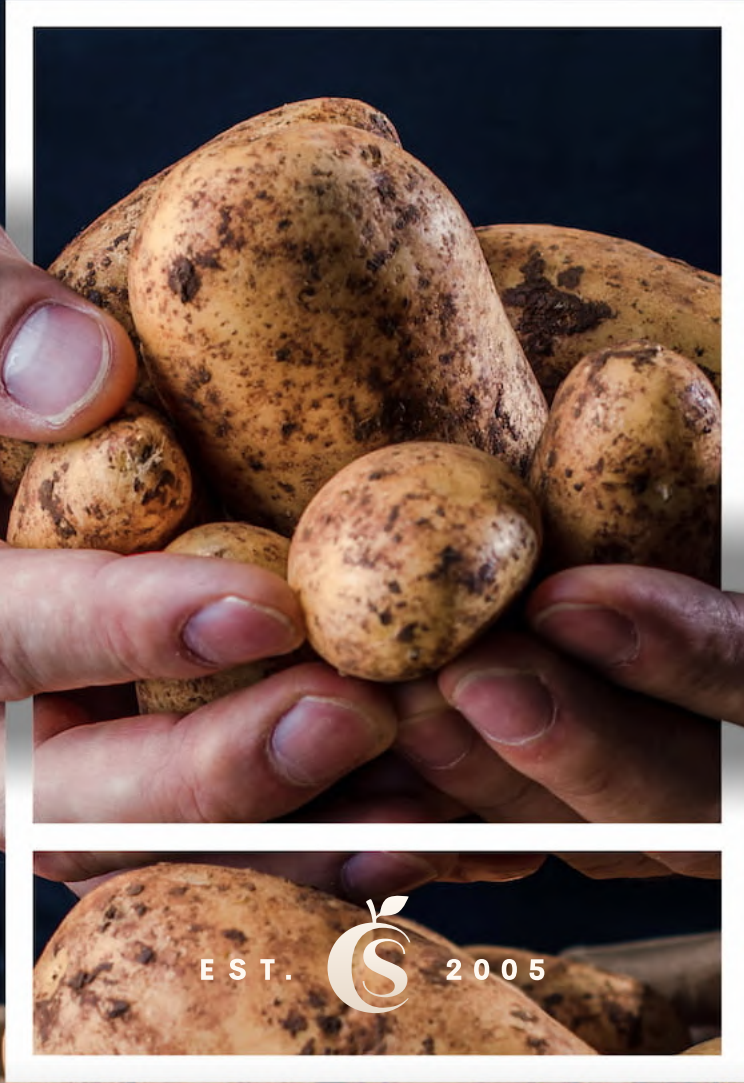

SEPTEMBER TOP INSIGHTS



- The English lettuce salad season has about a month left before we move over to Spanish. Spanish Cucumbers, Aubergines and Peppers have all started to arrive
- European stone fruit, peaches, nectarines & apricots are past their best
- English cauliflowers are bigger and better due to sunnier weather
- Oranges and lemons have been getting scarcer as we move over to South African prices

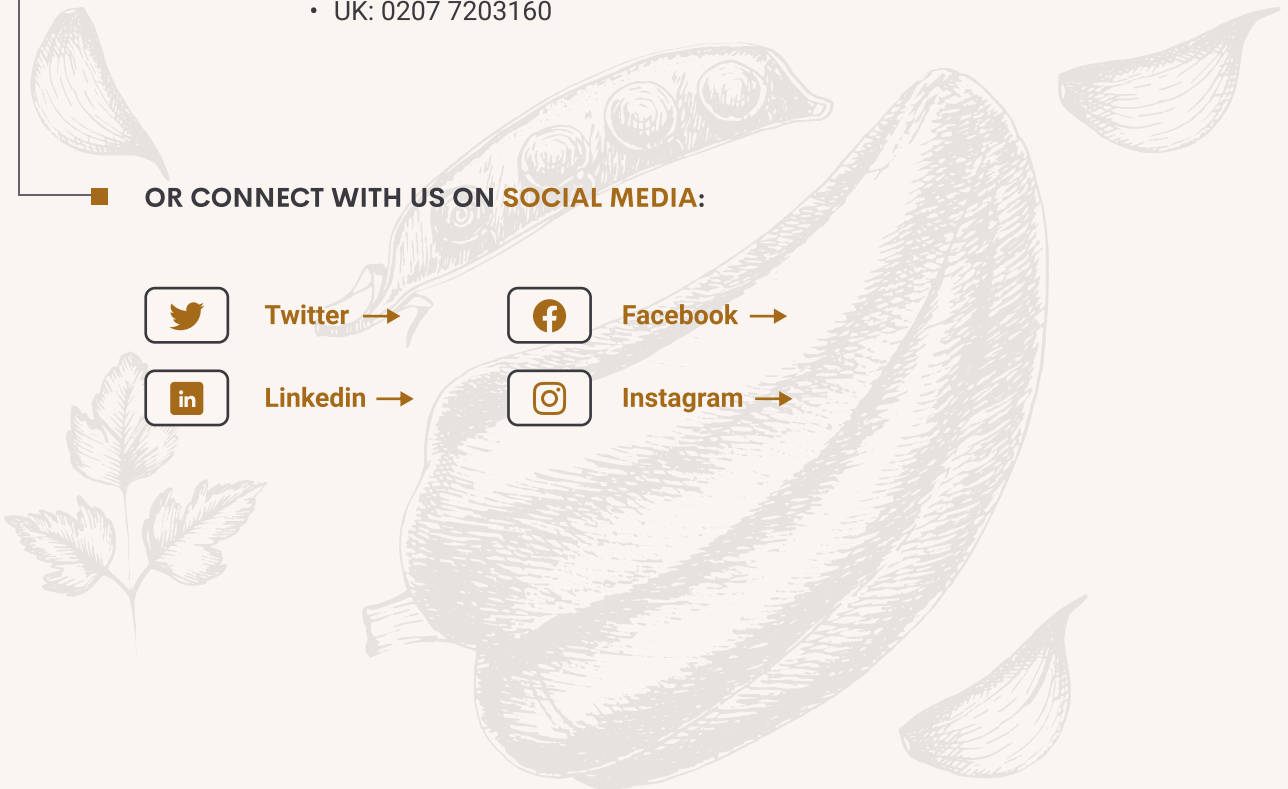
