■ NOVEMBER TOP INSIGHTS



Over the past two months, the price of eggs has rapidly increased and our supply has decreased due to the following three factors:

- The war in Ukraine has caused the price of energy and feed to increase for farms. As a result, **many farms have been unable to replace and rear egg producing chicks**, causing a shortage across the UK and Europe.
- Last week, one of the biggest colonies – which houses over 300,000 birds – was hit with bird flu fuelling an even larger shortage.
- We rely on farms having surplus eggs, as our suppliers often have large contracts with the major supermarkets. **While we are currently working incredibly hard to get new contracts in place, many farms are only able to supply the major retailers due to the current shortage in supply.**
